## In-Person Absentee Voting Ends Tomorrow

**(Columbus)** The Franklin County Board of Elections reminds voters that in-person absentee voting for the primary election ends tomorrow, Friday March 2. Voters will be able to cast absentee ballots at the board of elections between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

As of this morning, 30,799 voters had requested absentee ballots for the primary and mailed back 19,505 voted ballots. The totals include 1,932 voting in person at the board so far.

## Important Deadlines:

- The deadline to apply for an absentee ballot by mail is noon Saturday, March 3. The board of elections will only accept applications by mail on Saturday.
- Absentee ballots returned by mail within the United States must be postmarked no later than Monday, March 5 and arrive by Friday, March 16. Out-of-country military and civilian ballots must also arrive by March 16.

Applications are available at local libraries, on the Web at <u>http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov</u> or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3100.

Voted absentee ballots also may be returned to the board of elections until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day Tuesday, March 6. However, they may not be returned to any polling location open on Election Day.
