Franklin County Holds Special Election Tuesday
One Issue on Ballot for 8,400 Voters

(Columbus) Franklin County will hold a special election next Tuesday, Aug. 5 with one issue on the ballot –a school levy of 2.85 mills for voters registered within the county’s portion of the Licking Heights School District.

Some 8,400 voters in ten Franklin County precincts are eligible to vote on this issue and still have time to cast absentee ballots by mail or in-person. Absentee applications are available on the board’s Web site <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov> or by calling the board of elections at (614) 525-3100. Applications by mail must be received by noon this Saturday, Aug. 2.

In-person voting will be available at the board of elections located at 1700 Morse Road, at the following times:

- **Weekdays through Friday Aug. 1 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
- **Saturday, Aug. 2 from 8:00 a.m. to noon**
- **Sunday, Aug. 3 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
- **Monday, Aug. 4 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Local polling locations will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Unofficial vote totals will be posted on our Web site after the polls close Tuesday night.
