Voter Registration Deadline for the May 4th Special Election is April 5th

(Columbus) Franklin County residents that are not registered have until 9:00 p.m. Monday, April 5th to register to be eligible to vote in the May 4th Special Election. Only registered voters in Franklin Township, Mifflin Township, Pickerington Local School District, and the City of Upper Arlington will have an issue on the ballot.

Below are the requirements one must meet to be a qualified voter:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- A resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election
- Registered to vote at least 30 days before the election
- At least 18 years old on or before November 2nd, 2021

To register or update registration online please visit, <http://voteohio.gov> registrants will need to provide the following:

- Ohio driver's license or Ohio identification card number
- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Last four digits of your Social Security number

The Board of Elections, located at 1700 Morse Road, will remain open Monday, April 5th until 9:00 p.m. for voters to register or deliver their completed forms to our office.

Registrations by mail are acceptable if they are postmarked by April 5th, 2021. Registration forms are available at our office and on the Web at <http://vote.franklincountyohio.gov>. Forms may also be found at many government offices throughout the county.
