Expanded Early Vote In-Person Hours Begins Today

(Columbus) Today in-person voting hours expand an additional two hours a day. Voters this week will have a total of eleven hours a day to vote in-person at our office, see hours below. Through the first twelve days of early voting at the Franklin County Board of Elections, over 25,000 voters have requested a ballot by mail or voted in-person.

October 25 – 29

(Weekdays Only - Monday through Friday)

8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, October 30

8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Sunday, October 31

1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Monday, November 1

8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Voters who want to return their voted absentee mail-in ballots can deliver them to the board at 1700 Morse Road, Columbus. The board currently has one drop box with 24/7 access and potentially could add additional drop boxes onsite if necessary. Voters can also return their ballot by mail, but it must be postmarked no later than Monday, November 1. Those ballots can be received ten days after Election Day and included in the official certified results.
