Final Three Days of Absentee In-Person Voting

(Columbus) Three days remain to vote absentee in-person at the Franklin County Board of Elections. Below are the days and hours left to vote at our office, including hours this weekend. To date over 43,000+ registered voters have voted in-person and 48,000+ registered voters have requested a ballot be mailed to them.

Absentee In-Person Hours

Friday, November 3
7:30 AM – 7:30 PM

Saturday, November 4
8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Sunday, November 5
1:00 PM – 5:00 PM

Voters who want to return their voted absentee mail-in ballot can deliver them to the board, 1700 Morse Road. The board has a secure 24/7 drop box and a drive thru lane to drop off ballots that is only open during early voting hours.

Absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than Monday, November 6. If you can't get it postmarked by November 6 it needs to be delivered to this office, 1700 Morse Road, Columbus by 7:30 PM on November 7.

Franklin County will have 307 voting locations open on Election Day, Tuesday, November 7. Voters must go to their assigned voting location on Election Day to cast a ballot. Polls open at 6:30 AM and close at 7:30 PM.
