

NOTICE OF ELECTION ON ISSUE OF BONDS

R.C.133.18, 3501.11(G)

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Education of the Pickerington Local School District of Pickerington, Ohio passed on the 4th day of January, 2021, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 4th day of May, 2021, the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of ninety-five million dollars (\$95,000,000) for the purpose of expanding, renovating and improving Central High School and North High School; constructing, furnishing and equipping one junior high school, with related site improvements and appurtenances thereto; acquiring, renovating, furnishing and equipping existing facilities or constructing, furnishing and equipping new facilities for school district purposes, with related site improvements and appurtenances thereto; and repairing, improving and maintaining existing school buildings and facilities. The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 38 years. The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$0.29 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, which is 2.9 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2022.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
