Notice of Election on Tax Levy in Excess of the Ten Mill Limitation
R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Whitehall of Whitehall, Ohio, passed on the 1st day of February, 2022, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Primary Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 3rd day of May, 2022, the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of City of Whitehall for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, for the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a police department, or for the payment of other related costs.

Tax being an additional tax of 2.83 mills at a rate not exceeding 2.83 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.283 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
