

Notice of Election on Tax Levy in Excess of the Ten Mill Limitation ¹

R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Township Trustees of Mifflin Township Police District of Franklin County, Ohio, passed on the 20th day of December, 2023, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Primary/Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 19th day of March, 2024 the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of Mifflin Township Police District for the purpose of providing and maintaining buildings, motor vehicles, communication and other equipment used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent and part-time police personnel, including payment of the police officer employer's contribution required under Section 742.33 of the Revised Code, or the payment of costs incurred by townships as a result of contracts made with other political subdivisions in order to obtain police protection.

Tax being a replacement of a tax of 8.8 mills at a rate not exceeding 8.8 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$308 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for a continuing period of time.

The estimated annual collections of this levy is \$632,000.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
